Final DRM-FRAME Project Meeting in Brussels



On November 19, partners met in Brussels for the Final Transnational Project Meeting of the DRM-FRAME Erasmus+ project, hosted at the Connect Brussels Youth Center. The meeting marked the successful conclusion of the project, with partners reviewing results across all Work Packages, presenting the interactive training platform, and discussing feedback from the piloting phase to further refine its functionalities.

External participants from Alphabet Formation Brussels also joined the meeting, presenting their work under the EU DEM Fact Checking Network project. Their contribution underlined the vital role of fact-checking in raising societal awareness, especially during crises, where misinformation can have serious consequences.

The meeting concluded a project dedicated to strengthening disaster risk management and civil resilience across Europe. Partners expressed their appreciation for the strong collaboration and commitment shown throughout the project and look forward to building on these shared achievements through future initiatives.





DRM-FRAME Project Presented at International Conference on Emergency Management

On 19 November 2025, the DRM-FRAME Erasmus+ project was presented during the Hybrid Informative & Scientific Conference “Emergency Management in the Face of Natural and Man-Made Disasters”, organised by the Department of Emergency Planning and Crisis Management of the International Hellenic University in Serres, Greece. 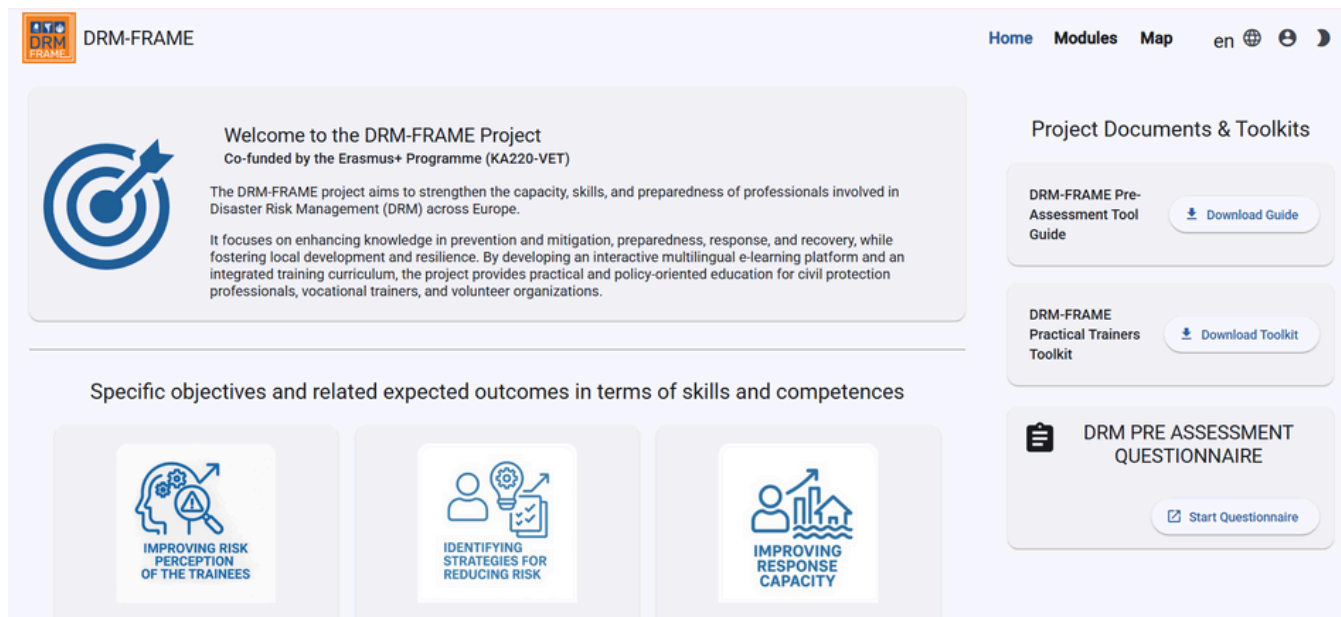

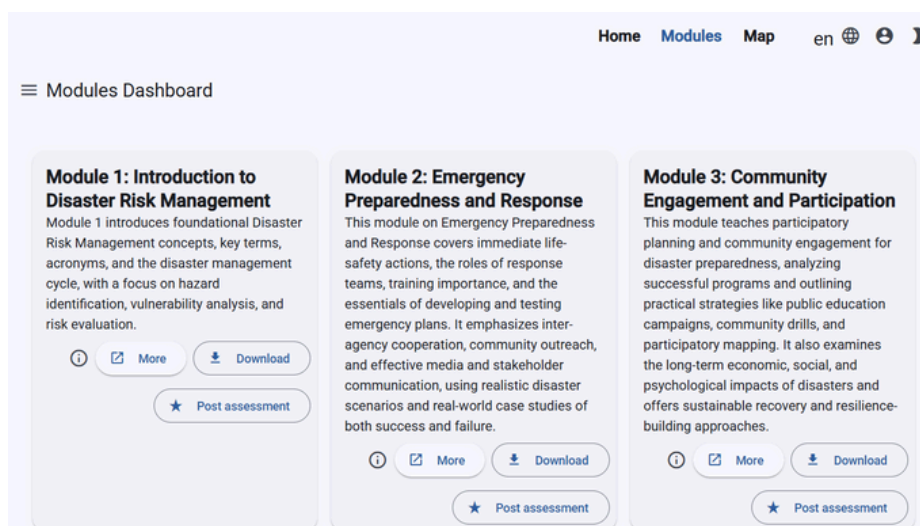


Deliverable Spotlight: The DRM-FRAME Platform

The DRM-FRAME Platform is an innovative digital learning environment designed to strengthen disaster risk management capacities across Europe. By combining structured learning modules with an interactive mapping tool, the platform supports professionals and communities in improving preparedness, response, and resilience, with particular attention to local contexts and cultural heritage protection.



Users can learn through **nine comprehensive modules** covering key areas such as disaster preparedness, emergency response, community engagement, inclusive approaches, advanced technologies, logistics, major disasters, and best practices. The curriculum allows learners to progress step by step, track their learning journey, and translate theory into practical skills applicable to real-life disaster scenarios.

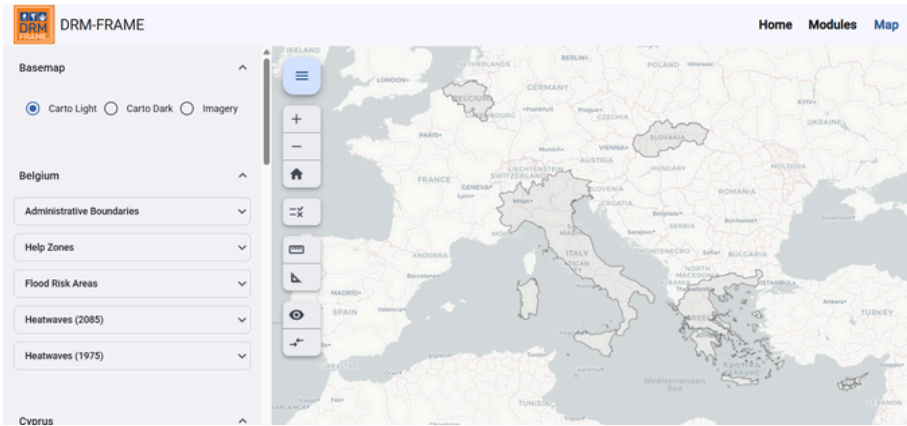

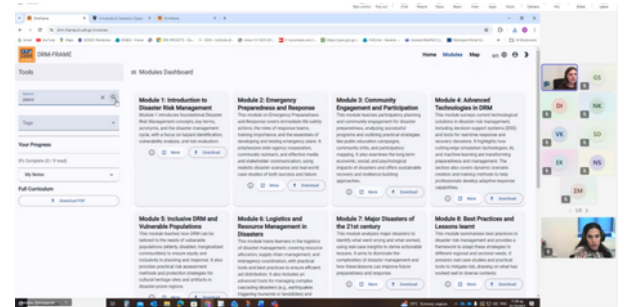




At the same time, users can explore risks and resources through an interactive map featuring multiple basemaps and thematic layers. Developed within the DRM-FRAME, the platform is designed for civil protection professionals, emergency services, policymakers, educators, researchers, and volunteers, turning knowledge into practical action for resilience and preparedness.



As part of the DRM-FRAME project, partners conducted pilot sessions with end users across participating countries to test the platform, gather practical insights, and identify areas for improvement. Feedback from professionals, trainers, and stakeholders directly informed the refinement of the platform’s content, usability, and functionalities, ensuring it responds to real needs in the field of disaster risk management.
